Violence against women is punishable

The situation for those, who are concerned by domestic violence, has improved distinctly because of the protection-against-violence law. Now Police and justice have more means to support victims. If your husband or partner has battered, kicked, threatened or even raped you, the police will bring a criminal charge against him.

The police can banish your husband or partner from the flat within a very short time. They can forbid staying in contact with you or take him into custody. The police can take up contact for you with the organisation "Women help Women".

You can go to a women's refuge to protect yourself either alone or with your children. There you will be safe from maltreatment. The colleagues there will support you by any further steps. Take all important documents with you, even those of the children:

- ID cards / passports
- family register, marriage - or birth certificate
- bank account card
- health insurance card

At the advice centres (see overleaf) you'll also find help and advice for your further decisions and more information about the violence-protection-law, too. If you don't have any money for legal expenses or court fees, you can file for a petition for advice assistance and/or procedural legal aid (former: legal aid) at the magistrates' court of your place of residence, either alone or with the help of a lawyer.

You can immediately apply for a judicial decision according to the protection-against-violence law to get the common flat allocated and/or a contact ban. To do that you can claim the service of a lawyer or you can take your case to court by yourself.

If available bring the following documents, please:

- ID card / passport
- tenancy agreement
- confirmation from the police about the charge and/or removal order
- a doctor's certificate in case you are hurt
